Dr Katoch has valuable contributions in the field of Tuberculosis, Leprosy and other health problems of rural population. Developed and evaluated several important regimens for treatment of leprosy i.e. clofazimine containing common regimen for PB and MB leprosy evaluated as uniform MDT of WHO; addition of Clofazimine to the PB regimen has been accepted and recommended by WHO in 2018 and implemented by NLEP, India. She has researched on many immunotherapies regimens for other infectious diseases. She has been instrumental in the launch of Model Rural Unit (MRU) and Model Rural Healthcare Units (MRHU) in India.

Dr Roli Mathur is a distinguished academician and researcher, recognized as a university topper and gold medalist during her graduation and post-graduation. She received the Young Scientist Award for her doctoral research in Molecular Genetics at AIIMS, New Delhi. A WHO fellow in "Bioethics and Ethics Committee Administration," she is trained as an international surveyor of ethics committees. Dr. Mathur serves as the Member Secretary of ICMR-Central Ethics Committee on Human Research, India's National Ethics Committee. She has contributed to numerous WHO expert groups, including Covid-19 Ethics, Artificial Intelligence in Health, and Clinical Research. As an Executive Committee Member of CIOMS, she co-developed ethics guidance for research in low-resource settings. Dr. Mathur has spearheaded the development of pivotal national guidelines, including the ICMR Ethical Guidelines (2017), RIPE Policy (2019), and DNAR Guidance (2020). Her extensive work includes building capacity for research ethics, conducting multicentric national research studies, and authoring a reference book, Biomedical Ethics Perspectives in the Indian Context (2022). She continues to shape research ethics policies and empower the research community in India.
