Summary:

On the occasion of World Water Day 2025, the Eco Club in collaboration with Himalayan School of Yoga Science (HSYS) organized a special lecture on "Glacier Preservation: A Key to Water Conservation and Environmental Sustainability." The event aimed to raise awareness about the importance of preserving glaciers as a crucial source of fresh water and their impact on global climate and ecosystems. The program commenced with an introductory speech by Mr. Raj Kumar Verma, who highlighted the theme of World Water Day 2025 and the urgent need to address glacier retreat due to climate change. On September 17th, 2024, Eco Club, in collaboration with Himalayan School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, a constituent academic unit of Swami Rama Himalayan University, and the Rural Development Institute to host a significant interactive session for its students. This event was designed to foster awareness about environmental issues and promote active participation in addressing ecological challenges.

The distinguished guest speaker for the occasion was Mr. Chandi Prasad Bhatt, one of India's most respected environmentalists. His contributions to environmental conservation, particularly in the Himalayan region, have earned him numerous prestigious awards: **1982: Ramon Magsaysay Award for Community Leadership**, recognizing his grassroots efforts to involve local communities in environmental protection, **2005: Padma Bhushan**, awarded for his contributions to environmental sustainability and social work., **2013: Gandhi Peace Prize**, presented by the President of India in 2014, acknowledging his commitment to peaceful activism and environmental stewardship, **2016: Sri Sathya Sai Award for Human Excellence** in the Environment category, awarded by the Sri Sathya Sai Lok Seva Trust for his lifelong dedication to ecological preservation, **2017/2018: Indira Gandhi Award for National Integration**, in recognition of his efforts to promote unity and environmental harmony in India.

During the session, Mr. Bhatt focused on increasing the students' understanding of the urgent environmental challenges currently facing the world, particularly in the fragile ecosystems of the Himalayas. He explained how the Himalayan region, home to vital ecosystems and diverse communities, is experiencing profound environmental degradation due to factors such as deforestation, climate change, overexploitation of resources, and pollution.

Mr. Bhatt shared insights from his own work in environmental conservation, shedding light on the ongoing projects aimed at preserving the Himalayan ecosystem. He highlighted the importance of sustainable development practices, reforestation efforts, and the promotion of community-led initiatives that engage local populations in protecting their environment.

He also addressed the critical need for collaboration between policymakers, scientists, and local communities to devise practical solutions for environmental protection. Drawing from his experiences in grassroots activism, Mr. Bhatt emphasized the role of education and awareness in fostering a sense of responsibility among young people. He encouraged students to become active

participants in environmental conservation, not only through advocacy but also by adopting sustainable habits in their daily lives.

This session served as an eye-opener for students, reinforcing the message that preserving the environment is not just a global responsibility but a personal one. Mr. Bhatt's powerful words inspired students to reflect on their role in safeguarding the environment for future generations, particularly in the context of the fragile yet vital Himalayan ecosystem.























