


- Demonstrate adequate knowledge of concepts, techniques, functions relevant to hospital administration

Eligibility: Candidate with minimum 50% marks in Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) or Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery (BAMS) or Bachelor of Homeopathic Medicine & Surgery (BHMS) or Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing or Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Life Sciences (with Biology in 10+2) or Bachelor's degree in any Paramedical programme or Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharma) from a recognized University.

OR

Sponsored candidate who has graduated in Science (with Biology in 10+2) from a recognized University and possesses a minimum 5 (five) years of related work experience.\*

\*Term "sponsored candidate" also includes candidates on "study leave" for 2 years with NOC from their departments.




# Master of Hospital Administration (MHA)
