## THE GUIDING FORCE

Born in 1925 in Toli, Malla Badalpur, Pauri Garwal, Uttarakhand, H.H. Dr. Swami Rama, a great Yogi, Philosopher, Scientist and Humanitarian, was mentored and inspired by many adepts, including Mahatma Gandhi, Sri Aurobindo, and Rabindranath Tagore. He received his higher education at Bangalore, Prayagraj, Varanasi, and Oxford University, England. In 1960 he completed his degree at the medical college in Darbhanga.

Swami Rama was initiated as Shankaracharya of Karvirpitham in South India in 1949. He renounced from the prestigious position in 1952 to return to the Himalayas and intensify his spiritual practices.

He worked as a medical consultant in London and assisted in parapsychological research in Moscow. He then returned to India, where he established a clinic and ashram, Sadhana Mandir Trust (SMT), in Rishikesh. Later he went to Japan, where he established a major spiritual centre.

At the behest of his master, he went to the United States in 1969, to build a bridge between east & west and demonstrate scientific way to spirituality.

Under laboratory conditions, Swami Rama demonstrated control of involuntary physiological parameters. These experiments were reported in many leading scientific journals and set the stage for the recognition of the psychosomatic origins of a majority of diseases, the development of biofeedback and holistic paradigms of health. His Yogic feats found special mention in Encyclopaedia Britannica 1973.

In the early 1970s, Swami Rama established the Himalayan Institute of Yoga, Science and Philosophy at Honesdale, USA.


He conceived and founded Himalayan Institute Hospital Trust (HIHT) in 1989 at Jolly Grant, Dehradun. The Trust opened a multi-specialty hospital in 1994 and a medical college in 1995 and continues to serve the people of Uttarakhand and India in the field of health, education, rural development, youth empowerment and much more.

13th November, 1996, Swami Rama left the mortal body however, the visionary sage continues to be the guiding force of the organization.





### Clean & Green 200+ acres, Ecofriendly Picturesque Campus

With its location at the foothills of the Himalayas and its proximity to the city airport, SRHU campus is eco-friendly & energy efficient, backed with rain water harvesting, sewage treatment plant and solar panels. 43% of University electricity is generated through solar power plants. Through our STP plant 700 cubic meter (7 lakh liters) of water is treated each day. Through rain water harvesting 4 lakh cubic meter (40 crore liters) ground water is recharged every year.

We also established Plastic Bank in association with Indian Institute of Petroleum (IIP) to convert single use plastic into diesel.

Moreover, the lush green spaces at our campus are home to variety and rare species of birds.
