

# Industry Talks and Guest Lectures

At Swami Rama Himalayan University (SRHU), guest lectures delivered by industry experts play a vital role in bridging the gap between academic learning and real-world practices. These insightful sessions are designed to provide students and faculty members with exposure to current industry trends, challenges, and innovations. By connecting academic knowledge with practical applications, these lectures inspire critical thinking, foster innovation, and prepare students to meet industry expectations confidently. Additionally, they provide valuable networking opportunities, enabling participants to interact directly with professionals, gain insights into career pathways, and explore collaborative research prospects. These sessions reinforce SRHU's mission to cultivate industry-ready graduates and promote a culture of continuous learning and innovation.

### **Distinguished Guest Lecture**

Nobel Laureate and eminent biochemist Dr. Aaron Ciechanover delivered a distinguished lecture at SRHU on March 30-31, 2023, highlighting the critical role of bioethics in medicine. He addressed the challenges faced by healthcare professionals, particularly in oncology and during the COVID-19 pandemic, where ethical dilemmas arose in patient care prioritization and transparency about terminal illnesses. Dr. Ciechanover emphasized the societal impact of misinformation, historical injustices in healthcare, and vaccine hesitancy while sharing insights from his Nobel-winning research on ubiquitin-mediated protein degradation. The lecture concluded with an engaging Q&A session, offering a platform for thought-provoking discussions on medicine and ethics.











### Guest Lecture on "Securing a Resilient Future: Sustainability in Reference to Uttarakhand"

The Himalayan School of Biosciences at Swami Rama Himalayan University (SRHU) organized a one-day forum on May 31, 2023, titled "Securing a Resilient Future: Sustainability in Reference to Uttarakhand." The event aimed to contribute to the ongoing G-20 discourse on sustainable development in the Himalayas and explore strategies to address climate change challenges. The forum featured discussions on climate adaptation, renewable energy, ecosystem services, sustainable tourism, and community-based conservation. Dr. K.K. Pant, Director of IIT Roorkee, delivered the keynote address, highlighting IITR's contributions to Uttarakhand's sustainable development. Additional insights were shared by Dr. Rajendra Dobhal on sustainable practices and Dr. C.S. Nautiyal on research initiatives for the state's growth. The forum, convened by Dr. Sanjay Gupta, saw active participation from 265 students across various schools at SRHU, fostering collaborative discussions on securing a sustainable future for Uttarakhand.











# Infrastructure Development

### **Infrastructure and Learning Resources**

The University is home to a 1200-bed super-specialty teaching hospital, including 960 teaching beds, accredited by the National Accreditation Board for Hospitals (NABH). It features AYUSH therapy centers and advanced central diagnostic laboratories accredited by the National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL). These laboratories are equipped with modern automated diagnostic equipment and a pneumatic shoot system, offering high-tech diagnostic services, research opportunities, and comprehensive training. Diagnostic facilities such as a 1.5 Tesla MRI, 128-slice Spiral CT scan, PET scan, Gamma Camera, Hi-tech Ultrasounds, Mammography, Echography, Cardiac Cath Labs, Neurology and Sleep Labs, and Endoscopic Labs significantly enhance hands-on training for medical and paramedical students. The dedicated Cancer Centre provides comprehensive cancer care, including radiotherapy and Bone Marrow Transplants. Additional facilities include a state-of-the-art Dialysis Center with renal transplant capabilities, a Learning Disability Clinic (LDC) collaborating with clinical departments to support children with learning disorders, and a unique Cadaveric Lab in northern India offering hands-on learning with advanced simulation technologies. The Skill and Simulation Center of Excellence (SSCE) is Uttarakhand's first and only facility of its kind, providing cutting-edge healthcare education through immersive simulation training. The University also features fully ICT-enabled classrooms, seminar halls, The engineering and management colleges are equipped with museums, and advanced laboratories. computer labs featuring the latest software for specialized training, including communication, language learning, data analysis, accounting (TALLY), business simulation, and audio/speech therapy, ensuring students receive a comprehensive and modern educational experience.



























### **Digital Infrastructure**

The University operates two data centers: a primary data center and a disaster recovery center, featuring 14 physical and 32 virtual servers. It utilizes BSNL NKN OFC with a 1 Gbps bandwidth and JIO OFC Link with 500 Mbps bandwidth. Over 1,225 desktops are available across campus, with internet access provided via LAN in all laboratories for student use. Security is maintained with two regularly updated firewalls. The Cyberoam firewall, in use since 2018, was upgraded to Sophos 310 in 2020 and further enhanced to XGS 3300 in October 2023. Wireless connectivity is available in select areas through 50 installed access points, supported by a 24/7 UPS backup system for all IT infrastructure. Airtel FTTH service is also available in staff residential areas. Classrooms, labs, conference rooms, and seminar halls are equipped with LCD projectors and internet access. The University leverages enterprise-level applications, including Akhil Miracle HIS, JUNO ERP & LMS, NoPaperForms, Sage HRMS, and Turnitin. Additionally, platforms such as Microsoft DreamSpark, Adobe Creative Cloud, D Space, Faculty/Curriculum Feedback, KOHA Library Management System, Google Workspace for Education, and SMS services support academic and administrative functions.








## **E-Content Development and Digital Learning Initiatives**

The University's commitment to digital learning is reflected in the establishment of an E-Content Development Cell, which ensures quality content creation and faculty training in line with university guidelines. The use of the KYAN all-in-one teaching device and smart boards enhances interactive teaching and engagement, supporting both classroom and virtual learning environments. A state-of-the-art studio with advanced equipment, including green screens, teleprompters, and high-definition cameras, supports the production of high-quality e-content. Additionally, the University's partnership with INFLIBNET LMS (ILMS) expands access to a vast array of e-resources, research materials, and courses via platforms like e-PG Pathshala. The establishment of a SWAYAM NPTEL Local Chapter offers students access to MOOC courses, providing opportunities for additional certifications and skill development beyond traditional classroom learning.









## **ICT-Enabled Learning at the University**

The University integrates advanced ICT tools and online resources to enhance teaching and learning experiences, including multimedia presentations, smartboards, virtual classrooms, and 100% ICT-enabled classrooms equipped with Wi-Fi and broadband connectivity. The E-learning lab offers video conferencing facilities, supporting a seamless learning environment.

### Key ICT initiatives include:

- 1. Integrated Digital Teaching Device: Leveraged by the E-Content Development Cell for high-quality e-content production, faculty receive regular training to create comprehensive learning resources accessible anytime.
- 2. INFLIBNET LMS Partnership: The platform offers courses, video lectures, and interactive materials across disciplines, enhancing learning through e-PG Pathshala and extensive research resources.
- 3. Multimedia Presentations: Faculty employ interactive content to engage students and improve comprehension.
- 4. Central Library Resources: The e-Library provides 8002 e-books, 7004 journals, and access to reputed health science literature from global publishers like Elsevier and BMJ Publishing, encouraging research and independent learning.
- 5. SWAYAM NPTEL Local Chapter: Offers access to MOOC courses for skill development and additional certifications.
- 6. Flipped Classroom Model: Platforms like Google Classroom and Microsoft Teams enable flexible, interactive learning, fostering engagement through virtual group activities and discussions.

SSCE conducts regular training programs like Basic Life Support, Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support, Pediatric Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support, Neonatal Advanced Life Support, First Aid & CPR, Intensive Care Unit Procedures, Airway Management, Intravenous Access, Surgical Suturing, Trauma Management, Gynecological & Obstetrics Procedures, Abdominal Assessment, Rectal Examination, Paracentesis, Spinal Procedures, Sonography Modules, and Basic Patient Care Procedures etc. The Skill and Simulation Center is committed to supporting and participating in offering high quality education to individuals and assisting in their preparation to be effective and compassionate health care providers in accordance with standards established nationally.

• The Suryamitra Skill Development Program focuses on building resilient infrastructure, promoting sustainable industrialization, and fostering innovation. The program trains individuals in solar photovoltaic systems, equipping them with the skills to operate, maintain, and install solar power systems, contributing to clean energy solutions. By offering hands-on training through industry visits and practical experience, the program enhances the technical capabilities of the workforce, promotes innovation in the renewable energy sector, and supports the growth of green industries. Additionally, it fosters entrepreneurship and offers employment opportunities, helping to build sustainable industrial infrastructure and contribute to economic growth in the renewable energy sector.



• The General Duty Assistant (GDA) program at Swami Rama Himalayan University, with a sixmonth duration, focuses on competency-based learning to prepare candidates for roles as healthcare assistants in hospitals and home care settings. The program emphasizes essential skills such as patient handling, comfort, safety, and basic care needs. Students gain knowledge through classroom teaching, demonstrations, and practical clinical experience.
