Professor Preeti Kothiyal, an alumnus of erstwhile Hamdard College of Pharmacy, Delhi University (now Jamia Hamdard, New Delhi) is a M. Pharm and Ph.D in Pharmacology. A dynamic personality, highly disciplined with a great academic record. Prof. Preeti has a vast experience of 30 years in academics, research and administration and has held numerous administrative positions such as Principal, Director and Pro Vice-chancellor.

Prof. Preeti Kothiyal completed one full term of 3 years as Vice Chancellor of Dev Bhoomi Uttarakhand University, Dehradun (2022-2025) and bears the unique distinction of being the First Woman-Pharmacy Professional as Vice Chancellor in the country.

She has more than 118 research publications in various National and International Journals of repute, and has presented research articles at various Conference and Seminars of academic interest.

Prof. Preeti has supervised more than 70 PG Students for their dissertation work, 04 doctoral thesis and is presently guiding 06 Research Scholars for their doctoral thesis.
