**Notice for NRI Quota Admissions into undergraduate medical –
MBBS programme, Academic session: 2026-27**

1. It is hereby informed that for the academic session 2026-27 under Foreign Indian Students (NRI–Non Resident of India) Quota, admissions to undergraduate medical–MBBS programme conducted at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, a constituent academic unit of the Swami Rama Himalayan University, shall only be made based on the merit of NEET-UG-2026 through common counselling conducted by the State Government or its designated authority and none else.
2. The Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, has permission from National Medical Commission, formerly known as Medical Council of India, to admit 250 candidates in MBBS programme. Further, the Government of Uttarakhand vide letter no. 425679/XXVIII(5)/2026-(E-106382) dated 24/08/2026 has permitted the admission of students under the 15% NRI quota from the All-India Quota. Admissions to NRI quota shall be subject to the conditions stated in the aforesaid government orders and counseling board.
3. All NEET-UG-2026 qualified candidates are invited to register for the process of common counselling & admission into Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences. For registration process and other related details for common counselling, kindly visit the website www.hnbumu.ac.in
4. **Fee :**

The tuition fee for **full MBBS course** applicable to candidates seeking admission under the NRI quota shall be **US\$ 1,60,000/- (US dollars One lac sixty thousand only)**, inclusive of admission fee.

5. **Note:**

- (i) The fees for Professional Phase-I shall continue to be charged till the candidate passes out the Professional Phase-I University Examinations.
- (ii) The candidate must pass Professional Phase-I in 12 (twelve) months; otherwise, tuition fees shall be charged as follows:
 - (a) If a student fails or is detained in 01 (one) subject in Professional Phase-I University Main Examinations and does not pass supplementary examinations, that is conducted immediately after the main University Examinations, he/she shall pay 1/3 (one-third) amount of the existing tuition fee per annum as additional tuition fee till the student passes out Professional Phase-I Examinations.
 - (b) If a student fails or is detained in 02 (two) subjects in Professional Phase-I University Main Examinations and does not pass supplementary examinations, that is conducted immediately after the main University Examinations, he/she shall pay 2/3 (two-third) amount of the existing tuition fee per annum as additional tuition fee till the student passes out Professional Phase-I examinations.

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- (c) If a student fails or is detained in all the subjects in Professional Phase-I University Main Examinations and does not pass supplementary examinations, that is conducted immediately after the main University Examinations, he/she shall pay full existing tuition fee as additional tuition fee per annum till the student passes out Professional Phase-I University Examinations.
- (d) **Provided under no circumstances the student shall be allowed more than four (04) attempts for Professional Phase-I MBBS and no student shall be allowed to continue undergraduate medical course after ten (10) years of joining the first MBBS course (including continuous rotatory medical internship).**
- (iii) After passing the Professional Phase-I Examinations, every student must pass Professional Phase-II, Professional Phase-III Part-I & Professional Phase-III Part-II in 42 (forty-two) months. If he/she fails to do so, he/she shall pay ½ (half) amount of the tuition fee determined by the University for Professional Phase-III Part-II as an additional tuition fee per annum till he/she passes Professional Phase-III Part-II University Examinations.
- (iv) As per the orders passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court from time-to-time, the candidate is required to furnish either cash security or bank guarantee for the fee payable for the remaining period of the programme.

Therefore, all candidates who obtain admission at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences shall be required to submit at the time of joining, either a bank guarantee for the balance unpaid tuition fee

OR

Post-dated cheques in favour of **Swami Rama Himalayan University** for the balance unpaid tuition fee.

The bank guarantee / cheques will be encashed by the University in case the candidate leaves the programme midstream, after the last date of admission.

2. Copy of Student Visa / OCI in case of Foreign Citizens (original to be produced for verification)
3. Affidavit of the person who is NRI and the Sponsor.
4. Documents claiming the sponsorer is an NRI (Passport, Visa of the Sponsor).
5. Embassy Certificate of the Sponsor (Certificate from the Consulate)
6. Sworn Affidavit endorsed by the concerned embassy as per MEA approved format showing that the Bonafide Guardian will bear the entire course fee of the candidate. (Certificate from the consulate issued within last 06 months).
7. Self-attested declaration as per MCC notification Ref. U-11011/07/2025-MEC dated 02nd August, 2025 (Attached).
8. Financial Proof – Bank Statements / Salary Slips of the sponsor.
9. Relationship Certificate of NRI with the candidate verified by a competent revenue or local authority to prove the blood relation between the candidate and the sponsor.

Those candidates who have been found Eligible so far (as per list attached) need not send their documents again. Candidates are advised to send all documents enclosed in single mail only, within stipulated time.

The eligibility of candidates for seats reserved for NRI is 'Provisional' based on the documents submitted by the candidates which will be verified by the allotted college authorities at the time of reporting and the Embassy Certificate will be sent to the Ministry of External Affairs/ respective High Commissions for verification. If found 'FAKE' at any point of time, the Provisional Allotment of candidate will be cancelled and action will be initiated by the competent authority against the candidate and the allotted college.
